As a nationally recognized community health center model, AHS stands at the forefront of quality and innovation. We address the unique cultural beliefs, language needs, attitudes and values of our patients. We provide healthcare for all and advocacy for the underserved.

- Founded in 1974 and headquartered in Oakland, California
- Internal Medicine, Geriatrics, Family and Pediatrics with specialties in Cardiology, Dermatology, Gynecology, Psychiatry and HIV
- ❖ Team-based patient care with over 50 medical providers, along with patient navigators, on-site interpreters, health coaches, perinatal counseling and labor coaches.
- Most comprehensive dental services with 15 providers, including four specialists in endodontics, periodontics, oral surgery and pediatrics
- Integrated health, counseling, education and advocacy programs and services

- 27,000 patients served a year
- 117,000 patient visits a year
