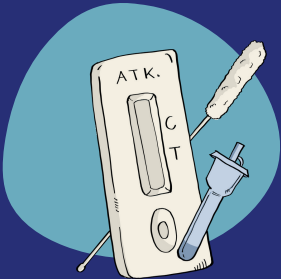
## THINGS TO KNOW

### PCR TESTING WILL PAUSE BRIEFLY

Alameda County is restructuring our health services to best meet your needs. **Starting August 1, 2023, PCR tests may not be available until further notice.**

### FREE RAPID ANTIGEN TESTING IS STILL AVAILABLE

A rapid test is just as effective if used properly. If you have symptoms and test negative, isolate, mask in public, and test again every 1-2 days.
